Areas & Weights:

• Circle Arena & 8 Boxes with difference in weights.

Assessment Scheme

- Points will be given to the team by the values assigned to each box.
- Each box point will be given according to given box values.
- Boxes values varry from 50 points to 1000 points.
- Complete points will be given only if boxes are placed accurately inside the circle arena.
- Those team who complete this in less time will win.



Event Description :

AutoCoders was the event with a great blend of vivid coding activities, enabling the coders out there to unleash their potential! Compete and challenge yourself to overcome the brilliant minds.

The Event was divided into 3 rounds -

Round 1: Fumble Bee Quizzz

Fumble-bee was an online quiz competiton, a platform was used for fumble-bee was Kahoot. The quiz was consist of 30 mins consisting of 45 questions, each with a time limit of 40 seconds. This round was designed to test your knowledge about coding, programming concepts and debugging. 25% of participants were eliminated in this round.

Round2: Decepti-code

The most amazing part of the contest was this round ,In this round the participants were required to code the solution of a simple

problem statement, sounds easy ? Well here's the knack - you've to code intuitively. (your code was invisible). We had provided the blind coding platform to them both the curser and the keyboard input were invisible to them.25% of participants were eliminated in this round.

Round 3: Computus Prime

This round was the heart of our event. This round was purely based on competitive coding. CodeChef was the platform provided by us to the participants for this round. 10 finalist were participated in this round.

EVENT DESCRIPTION:

ROUND-1: Speak to lead

- This round was an elocution round where each participant were given topics beforehand to prepare and they were suppose to speak on their respective topics for 3 mins.

- Top 10 participants were qualified for Round-2 based on the points given by judges.

ROUND-2: Unrehearsed

- It was an extempore round, where participants were provided with topics 1 minute prior to their performance They were suppose to speak for 4 min on the given topic, they were notified at the end of third minute.
- Topics were supposed to be chosen by them by picking one chit with random topic.
- Top 5 participants were selected for Round-3 based on their marks given by judges.

ROUND-3: Spin a Yarn

- This was a final round of Communix 4.0.
- Here, the finalists were provided with a list 20 unique words to each participant, they were given 2 mins to grasp those words and create story out of it using all those words.
- After 2 mins , they had to narrate their story to the audience and judges.
- Out of 5, two participants were declared as winners based on their performance.

- For this event, there were 23 online and 5 on spot entries from various colleges.
- For Round-1, in all there were 24 participants.

Event Description

The event was split into 3 rounds.

Round 1 – Decode your moves

In the first round, participants have to solve coding problems to unlock chess pieces. The difficulty level of these questions will be as follows:

- Question type pawns Easy aptitude questions worth 8 points.
- Question type Bishops and Knights Medium aptitude and easy level coding questions for 3 points each.
- Question type Rook medium aptitude / medium coding for 5 points each.
- Question type Queen Hard aptitude / medium coding for 9 points.

The participants will be scored according to the above scheme and they will be allowed to choose the pieces to redeem.

Round 2 – Squared Rook

The second round is entirely a chess event. All players from round 1 will be paired and they will play a game of chess using the pieces they have redeemed.

The roster for round 3 was chosen by elimination.

Round 3 – Brisk Check

This was a rapid questioning round based on both, chess and coding questions. A time limit of 30 seconds was set.
